

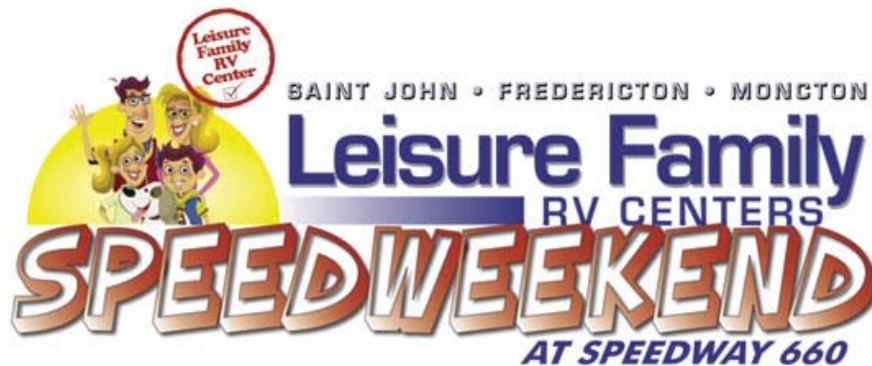

Qualifying and Race Procedures

Qualifying

- Heat Races - Each team will draw for starting position in their heat race.
Four (4) heat races, each 15 laps.
Top five (5) from each heat will qualify to the 150.
Finishing pos in heats will determine starting pos in the 150.
Cars finishing 6th and back will move to the last chance event.
- Last Chance – Top four (4) cars will advance to the feature.
If two last chance races are requirement based on car count then 2 from each last chance will advance to feature.
- Provisionals - Position 25 and 26 will be awarded to the top 2 teams in the 2008 Martins Home Heating Sportsman Points that have not already qualified. If all Speedway 660 cars in attendance have qualified then the two provisionals will be promoter's option.

Race Procedures

A mandatory caution will be thrown at lap 75. At this point we will run pace laps until the field has been verified in proper order and then we will stop along the inside lane on the front stretch.

Cars MUST remain on the track during the mandatory caution. Any cars leaving the track to go to the pits after caution has flown will be assessed a TWO lap penalty. Cars that need to go to the pits after the mandatory caution will have the opportunity when the pace laps are underway before restarting the race. These cars will re-join the field at the rear.

Two pit crew members are allowed to go to the front stretch to service the cars.
Fuel, Tire pressure, jacking bolts (provided they are accessible from outside car), windshield cleaning, driver refreshments etc..... Under no circumstances are the hoods to be lifted or work to be done under the hood.

Cars one (1) lap down will remain in line for restarts until (or around) lap 120. Cars multiple laps down will restart at the rear of the field on each restart.

No tire can be changed during the race unless it is flat and verified by tech officials.
