# Qualifying and Race Procedures

## Qualifying – Based on 30 Cars or less.

- Heat Races**
- Each team will draw for starting position in their heat race.
  - Three (3) heat races, each 10 laps.
  - Finishing pos in heats will determine starting pos in the 150.
  - **All** cars must go to tech following the Heat Race.
  - Cars will have their Tires marked as they come off the track. The tires you qualify on, will be the tires you Race on.
  - Cars failing Post Heat Race tech will start dead last in feature.
  - Any car that stops anywhere in the pits after their heat race, and before going to Tech will start dead last in feature.

## Race Procedures

Driver introductions will be done with Driver OUT of the vehicle, and 1 or 2 (no more than 2) crew members on the front stretch. This will take place during the intermission break of the night.

After the cars Roll and double up, we will be bringing everyone to a complete stop on the front stretch and turning ALL ENGINES OFF.

We will be holding a moment of silence in formation, in memory of Chris Hanley.

There will be 1 wave off lap.

Starts and Restarts will take place inside the Starters Box. **Hold pace car speed until you reach the first white line.** At this point the leader can decide to go between the first and second white lines. If they do not go before line #2, it will be a green flag race. All restart calls will be at the discretion of the Race Director.

Cars being lapped, please hold your line on the bottom of the track.

Cars one (1) lap down will remain in line for restarts until (or around) lap 120. Cars multiple laps down will restart at the rear of the field on each restart.

No tire can be changed during the race unless it is flat and verified by tech officials. A Flat tire is considered Flat when you roll off the track. If a tire is changed, and it is not flat, the team will be DQ from the race.

There will be a lucky dog in affect for the first car 1 lap down. To receive the lucky dog, the car cannot be part of, or cause the caution. The Lucky dog car cannot pit under that caution. Lucky Dog can only be received once – starts dead last.

**NOTE: LAP 71 will be the 'half way' caution for on track refuel and tire pressures only**
