Qualifying and Race Procedures

Qualifying

Based on more than 26 Cars.

Heat Races -

Each team will draw for starting position in their heat race.

Four (4) heat races, each 10 laps.

Top five (5) from each heat will qualify to the 125.

Finishing position in heats will determine starting position in the 125.

Cars finishing 6th and back will move to the last chance event.

Last Chance –

Top four (4) cars will advance to the feature.

If two last chance races are requirement based on car count then 2 from each last chance will advance to feature.

Provisionals -

Position 25 and 26 will be awarded to the top 2 finishing teams from the Urquhart Construction Sportsman 150. If all Speedway 660 cars in attendance have qualified, then the two provisional's will be promoter's option.

Race Procedures

Cars one (1) lap down will remain in line for restarts until (or around) lap 120.

Cars multiple laps down will restart at the rear of the field on each restart.

No tire can be changed during the race unless it is flat and verified by tech officials.

There will be a lucky dog in affect:

The first car one lap down is the only car with an opportunity to receive the lucky dog. An eligible car will not be more than 1 lap down to the leader. The eligible car cannot be involved in nor have caused that caution. The eligible car cannot pit during that caution or a subsequent caution on the restart. Lucky Dog car must start at the tail end of the field After everyone else including lapped cars are double file.
